LIFT STATION 97 SEWER REHABILITATION PROJECT

W. IRLO BRONSON MEMORIAL HWY. (U.S. 192) AND FORMOSA GARDENS BLVD., KISSIMMEE

PROJECT DETAILS

Toho Water Authority (Toho) is scheduled to begin a sewer rehabilitation project in the Kissimmee area of Formosa Gardens Blvd. and W. Irlo Bronson Memorial Hwy. (U.S. 192) in mid-July 2022. The project is designed to upgrade the sewer facilities in the area.

WORK AREAS:

- U.S. 192 from south of Inspiration Dr. to south of Formosa Gardens Blvd.
- Formosa Gardens Blvd. from U.S. 192 to south of Funie Steed Rd.
- Formosa Blvd. at Drifting Lilly Loop

The project will involve replacing and relining sewer lines and manholes. Relocation of water lines may also occur.

Temporary lane closures will occur during the project. Sidewalks and driveways may be impacted by the project. Should driveways be impacted, notification will be issued beforehand. Area restoration will be conducted on affected areas.
