

Outside eastbound lane closure remains in effect on US 192 in Old Town area for additional sewer line repair

Kissimmee, Fla. (Tuesday, January 31, 2023) - Toho Water Authority (Toho) is announcing that the closure of the outside eastbound lane on US 192 from the area of Old Town and Seralago Blvd remains in effect (please see map). The bus stop in the closure area is also closed. The lane closure is necessary to conduct an additional sewer line repair in the area. The area is expected to reopen in about a week's time. Schedules could vary due to unforeseen circumstances and weather.

Motorists and pedestrians are urged to use caution when approaching these areas, as workers will be present and speed limits may be reduced and sidewalks possibly closed and diverted.
