



Update (February 28) – Road restoration on Narcoossee Rd

Kissimmee, Fla. (Tuesday, February 28, 2023) — Due to the ongoing road restoration in the Narcoossee Rd area and public inquiry, Toho Water (Toho) is providing periodic in-depth updates regarding the restoration efforts.

UPDATE DETAILS:

All road depressions caused by the installation of the 24" water main have been repaired. The contractor has also completed the 20-foot water main segment at Majestic Oaks Circle. Final paving of these areas between Boggy Creek Rd and Cyrils Dr is tentatively scheduled for March 20, 2023 and will take approximately 2 weeks to complete. This work will take place Sunday through Thursday from 9 p.m. - 6 a.m. Schedules could change due to weather and unforeseen circumstances.

The safety of everyone is of the upmost importance. Motorists and pedestrians are urged to use caution when approaching this area as lanes are temporarily shifted and workers may be present. Speed limits may be reduced and sidewalks possibly closed and diverted.

BACKGROUND

A water line was recently installed in the area to enhance pressure for Toho customers and meet the future needs of the growing community. An underground boring method was utilized to install the water line. This method minimizes the impact on area residents and the traveling public by eliminating the need for area excavation. Unfortunately, it was discovered that the installation caused three road depressions on Narcoossee Rd. The original road restoration plan had to be revised.
