



OSCEOLA PARK SEWER REHABILITATION PROJECT

NW of Osceola Park Drive and John Young Parkway



PROJECT DETAILS

Toho Water Authority (Toho) began a sewer rehabilitation project in the Kissimmee area northwest of Osceola Park Drive and John Young Parkway on January 26, 2023 (see map below). A timeline for the following work areas will be issued once they become available.

WORK AREAS:

- Eola Drive from Manor Drive to Hiawatha Drive
- Manor Drive from Eola Drive to Greenbrook Avenue
- Hiawatha Drive between Eola Circle and Greenbrook Avenue
- Manor Drive east of Eola Circle
- Manor Drive at Mesa Court

The project is designed to upgrade the sewer facilities in the area. Work also will replace stormwater lines.

Temporary lane closures have begun and others will occur during the project. Sidewalks and driveways may be impacted by the project. Should driveways be impacted, notification will be issued beforehand. Area restoration will be conducted on affected areas.

- Noise and vibrations
- Trucks, machinery and equipment
- Barricades for safety
- Possible odors from the sewer system
